

Panel Turns Thumbs Down on Prosperity Gold-Copper Mine project(aka Fish Lake)

The federal Panel reviewing the proposed Prosperity Gold-Copper Mine project(aka Fish Lake) this past week submitted its report to the federal Ministers responsible for deciding on whether the project can proceed. The Panel concluded that the project would result in significant adverse environmental effects on: - Fish and fish habitat; - Navigation;- Current use of lands and resources for traditional purposes by First Nations and on cultural heritage; and - Certain potential or established Aboriginal rights or title. The Panel also concluded that the project, in combination with past, present and reasonably foreseeable future projects would result in a significant adverse cumulative effect on: - Grizzly bears in the South Chilcotin region; and- Fish and fish habitat.
